The Uniform Exchange program provides clean uniform items to students who arrive at school without the correct uniform. We understand that there will be challenges from time to time with ensuring your child has the correct uniform items daily, and in these instances, we are here to help.


If your child forgets, doesn't have an item, or it is getting washed, no worries—we'll provide a uniform for the day. Students simply remove their incorrect uniform item and exchange it for the correct uniform item. At the end of the day, students return to the Uniform Exchange and swap it back. We just want to make sure all students are part of the team and develop their pride in representing South Street Primary School.

Over the last six months, we have implemented many supports to ensure all students are in the correct uniform, and I'm pleased to announce that, along with our Uniform Exchange, these will continue until the end of the year. This includes discounted uniform items, with shirts available for only \$8 and jumpers for only \$20.
