Dear students and families/carers,

I wanted to let you all know after three years as South St Primary School's school nurse I am sadly leaving at the end of this term, with my last day being Wednesday June 26th.

A number of months ago I moved to the beach and have been travelling back and forth from home to school while I continued to support students, staff, and families with anything health related. Although I am very sad to leave South St, I am very excited about my new role which will be based in Wonthaggi supporting kids living in Residential and Out of Home Care.

As the school nurse, I have made some great connections with students and their families/carers and have loved being part of the school community. I have especially loved coming in to the classrooms to teach sessions about handwashing, hygiene, puberty, periods, and reproduction. I've enjoyed the genuine curiosity students have about certain topics and the questions they ask. My aim for these sessions was to ensure students have the correct health information so they can make informed choices about themselves. During these sessions we had a few laughs, some awkward giggles, felt relief and reassured, and best of all some really positive conversations. My hope is that those positive conversations and curiosity continue at home and at school.

So as I spend my last couple of weeks at school, I would like to thank you all for your support over the years and wish you all the best...and I hope you enjoy the upcoming school holidays!



Chaplaincy Chat

Over the last few years the Chaplaincy Program has initiated support for community projects. We will as a school take on board a new project for 2024 supporting our local Anglicare Emergency Relief Foster Care Program. Anglicare Victoria is the states largest provider for out-of -home care services for children and young people. They provide many kinds of alternative homes

for those unable to live with their families due to safety or lack of nurturing.

In many cases children are removed from homes or court for placement in another home having only the clothes they are standing up in. They not only require continued emotional support but emergency provisions too.

At school we are aiming to engage any family members who are able to assist in providing some new essential items for all agesbabies, younger or older children.

Suggested items : BABY ITEMS T-SHIRTS UNDERWEAR SOCKS SHORTS JUMPERS TOILETRIES A CUDDLE TOY A FIDGET TOY.

These item would be passed onto Anglicare for Foster carers when the need arises.

If you are a sewer or know someone and can help make some cotton material Care bags with a draw string for us to place items in that would be awesome!!!

I will leave a bag in the school office as an example if you would like to check the size. Bright coloured material would be great and appeal to children. Op shops are a good place to look for material.

We will have collection boxes available at school the week of <u>September 9th – 13th</u>. If you require any clarification on anything. Please contact school. I am available Tuesdays/ Wednesdays/Fridays.

What these children are going through in life is tough. We want them to know that there are people out there who do care about them.
